


# **Best Green Education Initiative Award**



## **Application Manual of the Best Green Education Initiative Award**

### 1. Objectives

- To recognise schools' outstanding environmental education initiative in promoting sustainability and/or carbon neutrality.
- To gather good exemplars of environmental education practices in the schools sector.

### 2. Eligibility

- All registered pre-schools, primary schools and secondary schools under the Education Bureau are eligible to participate in the "Best Green Education Initiative Award" (hereafter referred to as the Special Award).
- Each school can only submit ONE environmental education initiative to compete for the Special Award.
- The Organisers reserve the right to determine the eligibility of any applicant school.

### 3. Assessment Criteria

Schools will be required to complete a **Summary Form** through the **online portal** for the outstanding environmental education initiative conducted **from September 2022 to February 2024 (i.e. 2022/23 school year and first term of 2023/24 school year), with the following assessment criteria:**

(1) Content	<ul> <li>Theme and objectives (relevance to sustainability and/or carbon neutrality)</li> <li>Programme details (implementation summary)</li> <li>Curriculum integration (how the initiative links to the school-based curriculum, including key learning areas, values education, STEM education, etc.)</li> </ul>	30%
(2) Stakeholders involvement and collaboration	<ul> <li>Involvement of different school members in planning and implementation stage</li> <li>Partnership with various parties of the school (e.g. different subject panels, activity clubs, parent-teacher association)</li> <li>Involvement of parents and/or community members</li> <li>Partnership with external organisations</li> </ul>	30%
(3) Design and creativity	<ul> <li>Activity design and mode of delivery (e.g. style, interaction)</li> <li>Originality and creativity</li> </ul>	20%
(4) Outcome and impact	<ul> <li>No. of participants / coverage</li> <li>Possible changes in knowledge, attitude and behaviour of participants</li> <li>Feedback from participants and evaluation</li> </ul>	20%

### **Important Notes:**

- Examples of environmental education initiative include but not limited to lesson plan, life-wide learning activity, whole-school campaign/initiative, activity organised by parent-teacher association.
- 2) Various modes of education initiative/activity including online, offline and blended modes would be considered.
- 3) Schools who participated in the "Best Green Education Initiative Award" **in the past two years** are <u>not</u> allowed to submit the same environmental education initiative as last two years. They are, however, welcome to participate in this year's Special Award with a different initiative.

On or before 6 March 2024 (Wednesday)	<ul> <li>Stage 1 – Self-assessment</li> <li>Participating schools are required to complete a Summary Form through the online portal (will be opened for filling in Jan 2024) for the outstanding environmental education initiative conducted from September 2022 to February 2024 (i.e. 2022/23 school year and first term of 2023/24 school year).</li> <li>The template of the Summary Form is enclosed in Appendix b for schools' reference only. Submission in paper/PDF format will not be considered.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>The technical consultant will review the Summary Form and supporting documents submitted by schools and may request supplementary information if necessary.</li> <li>Assessors will conduct on-site visit at participating schools who have submitted the Summary Form.</li> </ul>		

### 5. Award and Recognition

Schools will be awarded with certificates of recognition accordingly:

Award	Eligibility
Outstanding Award	Best 3 performing schools in each of the Pre-school, Primary School and Secondary School sub-sectors, and the schools should obtain 80 marks or above (Total: 9 awards).
	<ul> <li>Winning schools will receive the certificate at the Awards Presentation Ceremony.</li> </ul>
Certificate of Merit	Schools obtaining 60 marks or above.
	Schools will receive an electronic certificate as recognition.

### **Data Retention Policy**

This policy stipulates the kinds of personal data collected, means of collecting personal data, duration of retention, ways of using the personal data and data security measures for the "Best Green Education Initiative Award" (hereafter referred to as the Special Award).

### 1. Purpose of Collection and Use of Personal Data

The personal data provided in the summary form for the Special Award will be used for the following purposes –

- (a) for the administration, evaluation and management of the application for the competition by the Technical Consultant(s) of the Special Award; and
- (b) for the promotion of latest environment-related development, policies, activities and schemes by the Environment and Ecology Bureau and/or the Environmental Campaign Committee and its Secretariat.

### 2. Category of Personal Data

Each participant of the Special Award is asked to provide the (i) name, (ii) phone number, (iii) correspondence address and (iv) email address of a contact person ("Contact Person") in the summary form.

### 3. Means of Collection

The provision of personal data by the Contact Person in the Special Award summary form is voluntary. The summary form should be submitted through the online portal. If participating schools do not provide sufficient information, the processing of their applications may be affected.

### 4. Access to Personal Data

Each Contact Person has the right to request access to and correction of his/her personal data as stipulated in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Chapter 486). ### 5. Duration of Retention

The personal data collected from the Contact Person will be erased or destroyed 24 months after the completion of the assessment of the Special Award.
