I. Basic Environmental Badge Train-the-Trainer Training

- ◆ “Basic Environmental Badge Train-the-Trainer Training” is a video-based training. By watching the training video and completing the online assignment, teachers will be awarded the “Certificate of Qualified Trainer of Basic Environmental Badge for SEPAs” and will be able to deliver school-based BEB seminar to SEPAs.

II. Environmental Training Workshops

- ◆ The workshops aim to (i) familiarise teachers with general environmental knowledge; (ii) assist teachers in teaching different local environmental topics related to the workshops; and (iii) strengthen teachers’ capabilities in implementing environmental education which echoes with government initiatives.
